





The talk was very knowledgeable as well as interesting as the students were learning a new topic which they were curious to know about and could clear their doubts. Students enjoyed the session as it

was made very interesting by Shri Sawant. Students were made aware of the modes of transmission of HIV/AIDS as well as how to prevent the spread of the virus. After the talk, students were given an activity to check how much they have grasped from the talk. They were divided into four groups and were asked to plan

a small Skit/ Drama on awareness of HIV/AIDS and also give a title to their skit. All the students were very enthusiastic to present their skits and all four groups came up with new views, ideas and presented it very well on stage. The topics were on spreading HIV awareness to those who were unaware of the disease, unconditional love and support to PLHIV, on the importance of voluntary blood donation and blood



testing at ICTC. They were then asked to practice these skits and perform them during World AIDS Day to create awareness to other students and the community surrounding the school.
