

One Day Training Program in Awareness Generation on HIV/AIDS for Supervisory Staff (Health/Extension Educators, Sanitary Inspectors, Public Health Nurses and Lady Health Visitors) of Directorate of Health Services, Campal Panaji from all the CHCs, PHCs and UHCs was organized by Goa State AIDS Control Society, Panaji on 14th of February 2011 at Seminar Hall, Secretariat-Porvorim from 9:30 am to 5:30 pm. Dr. Pradeep Padwal, Project Director, Goa SACS formally welcomed the Chief Guest, Dr. Rajnanda Dessai, Director, Directorate of Health Services, Campal-Panaji, Officers at Goa SACS and the participants. HIV/AIDS SESSION CONDUCTED FOR NSS PROGRAMME OFFICERS


