Sensitization programme on HIV/AIDS for drop out students

Don Bosco Technical School under Ministry of Rural Development in collaboration with Goa State AIDS Control Society organized a sensitization programme on HIV-AIDS and Health related issues for the drop out students of Quepem taluka as well as other parts of Goa. Around 60 drop out students from Quepem taluka attended the sensitization programme. Resource persons for the programme were Shri Ramesh Rathod, AD (TI) from Goa State AIDS Control Society and Shri Sanjay Naik from Community Resource Foundation (CRF).

The training programme covered various topics like present scenario of HIV/AIDS in Goa, safe sex, myths and misconception, discrimination, STIs, condom usage, ICTC and ART service, routes of transmission, how to protect oneself from HIV/AIDS etc. and how to give care and support to those who are already infected with HIV/AIDS? All the myths and misconceptions were cleared by resource person Shri Ramesh Rathod, AD(TI), Goa SACS. Shri Sanjay Naik, Father Jose Sequeira and social worker Stephaine D'Souza from Don Bosco were present and appreciated the work of the Goa SACS and assured to extend full support in the future.

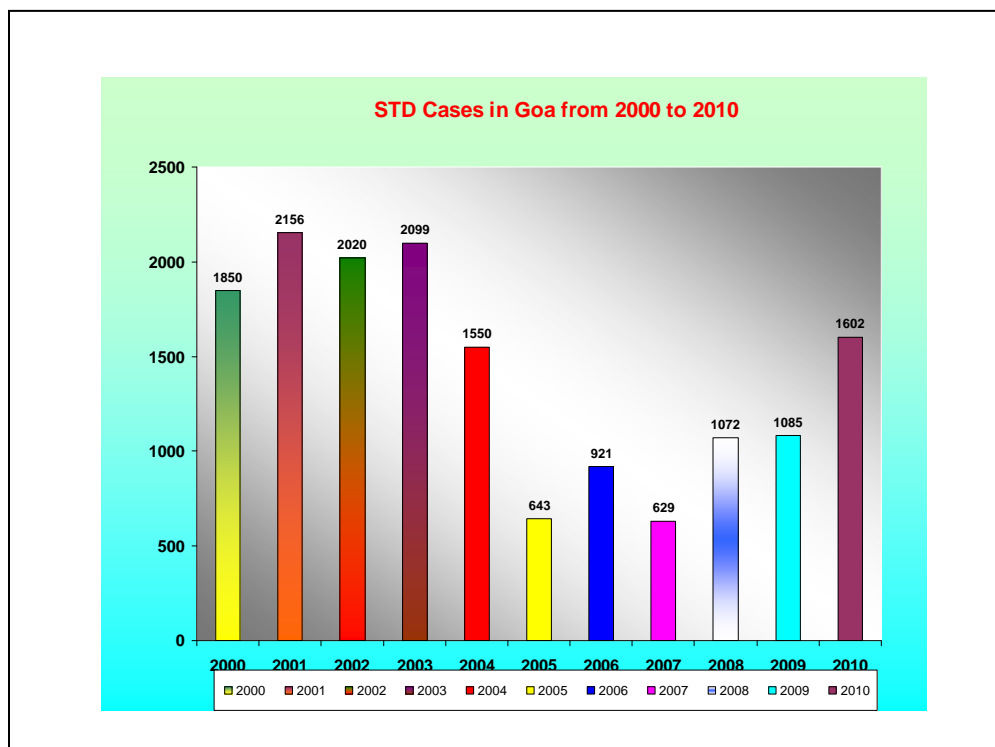
