The Red Ribbon Club (RRC) was inaugurated at Government Polytechnic Bicholim on 3rd February 2012 at 10.30 am by lighting the traditional lamp. Shri Umakant Sawant, DD (IEC), Ms. Jeunesse D. He also highlighted the need of prevention and spreading awareness among the youth in 16-45 age groups as these people are most vulnerable to STD. He further stressed on care, support and treatment of this dreadful disease AIDS. This was followed by an interactive question/answer session from the students. Ms. Jeunesse D. Fernandes, Consultant (Youth Affairs), Goa SACS spoke about activities to be carried out by Red Ribbon Club and its importance. Thereafter, short film songs on HIV/AIDS were screened. Mrs. Vibha Shenvi, Convenor for RRC-GPB proposed the vote of thanks. The programme was compered by Ms. Sneha Govekar, Shri Rameshwar Fadte handled Photography, Shri Ashish Surlakar & Shri Devendraprasad Kuvelkar provided technical support for success of the programme.
