INAUGARAL OF THE RRC UNIT

A Joint Inaugural of the NSS, YRC and RED RIBBON CLUB was held on the 28th of August 2012 in DM's PVS Kushe Higher Secondary School. The Chief Guest and the Guest of honour invited to the function were Mr. Manguirish Pai Raikar, the Chairman of Goa Chamber of Commerce and Dr. Rajnanda Dessai, the Project Director at Goa State AIDS Control Society.
